

**The IAMAW in Canada will also be showing support for the US IAMAW on the day of action planned for May 17.**

The Canadians are planning to target their own government and elected officials to let them know that they don't support outsourcing of aviation maintenance and repair jobs to other countries. They plan to approach passengers by handing out free baggage tags and asking them to support the Union's concerns by filling out a post card and sending it to the Canadian Minister of Transport. These activities will take place at airports and cargo areas and Canadian IAMAW members will briefly let them know that they don't support companies who outsource maintenance and repair jobs for Canadian aircraft to companies outside of Canada and will ask them for their support.

The IAMAW in Canada will be targeting the following airports across the country: Vancouver, Calgary, Winnipeg, Toronto, Montreal, and Halifax. This list may grow longer as May 17 approaches so watch this space.
