COMPREHENSIVE REVIEW OF THE STCW CONVENTION AND THE STCW CODE

Regulation VI/1, section A-VI/1 and section B-VI/1

Submitted by the International Shipping Federation (ISF) and the International Transport Workers' Federation (ITF)

SUMMARY

Executive summary: This document comments upon inconsistencies within the proposed

and security-related training and proposes a solution

Background

- The principles of the review of the STCW Convention and STCW Code were identified at STW 38 in February 2007. One of these was to address inconsistencies in the Convention and Code.
- 2 STW 41/7/6 contains draft amendments to chapter VI of the Convention and its associated Code provisions, to include requirements and guidance on security-related training in accordance with the International Ship and Port Security Code (ISPS).
- 3 STW 40/7/39, submitted by ISF, explained the ISF's concerns that the structure of the proposed amendments in respect of security-related training was inconsistent with the structure of the requirements for safety training. The latter state that, whilst familiarization training is required for all shipboard personnel, basic training is necessary only for those seafarers assigned designated safety and pollution prevention duties. However, the proposed text provides that all seafarers will require both familiarization and basic security-related training. It also provides for all seafarers to receive security awareness training. This concept originates from the ISPS Code and has no equivalent in respect of safety training.

In general, the level of security awareness training and the security familiarization training is comparable to the level of safety familiarization training. The difference is that the awareness training can be generic but the familiarization training is ship-specific. The awareness training could, for example, be delivered ashore. However, the ship-specific familiarization training must be delivered on each ship on joining, in line with the requirements for safety familiarization. The training for those with designated security duties is comparable to that of basic safety training, such as personal survival techniques, which is required for those with designated safety or pollution prevention duties.

Proposal

- ISF acknowledges that the STCW Convention and Code must reflect the stipulations of the ISPS Code. For this reason, taking into account the requirement for security-related awareness training, ISF considers that provisions as to security-related training should not be inserted into regulation VI/1, as proposed in STW 41/7/6, but instead be covered in a separate regulation. This would permit regulation VI/1 and associated Code provisions to remain concerned exclusively with safety training and avoid fitting security-related training into an unsuitable structure.
- The co-sponsors propose that the requirements concerning security-related training be placed in regulation VI/6, section A-VI/6 and section B-VI/6. These should set out the requirements for all seafarers to achieve the minimum standards of competence in security awareness currently specified in draft table A-VI/1-5 and to receive security-related familiarization training. They should also set out the mandatory minimum requirements for seafarers with designated security duties as currently specified in draft section A-VI/6, along with a statement setting out an Administration's power to apply exemptions where appropriate and transitional provisions. Annex 1 illustrates the proposal in tabular form.

Action requested of the Sub-Committee

The Sub-Committee is requested to consider the suggestions outlined in paragraphs 5 and 6 and take action as appropriate.
